Data processing guidelines for data processing through the Dairy Pulsator Tester application

Based on articles 13 and 14 of the REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: GDPR - General Data Protection Regulation) the data controller provides the following information to the affected parties about the processing of personal data.

2. Legal regulations forming the basis of the data processing

3. Data processing related to the registration

3.1. Processed data and purpose of data processing

Personal data	Purpose of data processing
User name	The user name is absolutely necessary for identification in the various data bases.
E-mail address	It is necessary for verifying the registration and for keeping contact with the customer.
Password	Allows a safe login to the user account.
Company name	Supplementary information to the user profile.
Telephone number	Allows keeping a quick and smooth contact.

It is not required to include personal data in the user name or in the e-mail address. For instance, it is not necessary to include your name in the user name or in the e-mail address. It is up to your free decision to specify a user name or e-mail address which could include information about your identity.

3.2. Legal basis for the data processing

The legal basis for the data processing is your consent.

3.3. Duration of data processing

Data mentioned in Paragraph 3.1 will be processed by Milkingo Kft. until you withdraw your consent. You may withdraw your consent by sending a letter to the e-mail address info@milkingo.com.

4. Access to the data and data security measures

4.1. Access to the data, and transferring the data

The personal data provided by you will be processed by the employees of Milkingo Kft. for the purpose of performing their job activities. Such activities include handling of documents, recording, providing assistance. The Data processor transfers your personal data only in exceptional cases to other government organisations. For instance,

- if a legal procedure affecting you is initiated at a court, and the relevant court of justice needs the transfer of document containing your personal data.
- if the police contacts the Data processor, and asks the transfer of documents containing your personal data for an investigation.

4.2. Data security measures

5. Your rights related to the data processing

5.1. Right of access by the data subject

You have the right to obtain from the controller confirmation in writing through the contact identified in Point 1 regarding:

- What kind of personal data.
- On what legal basis.
- Purpose of data processing.
- Source of data.
- Duration of processing.
- The data controller allowed access to what of your personal data to whom, when, on what legal basis, or transferred your personal data to whom.

The data controller will comply with your request within 30 days at the latest and will inform you about that by sending a letter to you contact address specified by you.

5.2. Right to rectification

You have the right to ask the data controller in writing through the contact identified in Point 1 to modify your personal data (e.g. you may change your e-mail address any time). The data controller will comply with your request within 30 days at the latest and will inform you about that by sending a letter to you contact address specified by you.

5.3. Right to erasure

You have the right to ask the data controller in writing through the contact identified in Point 1 to erase your personal data.

The data controller will comply with your request within 30 days at the latest and will inform you about that by sending a letter to you contact address specified by you.

5.4. Right to restriction of processing

You have the right to ask the data controller in writing through the contact identified in Point 1 to restrict the processing of your personal data. The restriction will last until the reason you indicated necessitates the restriction of data.

5.5. Right to object

You have the right to ask the data controller in writing through the contact identified in Point 1 to object the processing of your personal data, if the data controller forwards or uses the personal data for securing direct business, public opinion poll or scientific research. For instance, you may object if the data processor uses your personal data without permission from you for the purpose of scientific research.

6. Right to judicial remedy related to data processing

Initiating a court procedure

You may initiate a civil lawsuit against the data processor in relation to the unlawful data processing you became aware of. The ruling of the case will be brought by a court of justice. The lawsuit may be initiated – as you chose – at the court of justice having jurisdiction according to your domicile (the list of courts and their contact information can be accessed through the following link: http://birosag.hu/torvenyszekek).
